The logic behind the quality of towns is not their form (continuity of the built environment), but the ways in which space is organized to facilitate links between people. At the end of the 17th century, the desire to beautify space was combined with a concern for efficient urban functioning. But it was only at the end of the 17th century that the term "urbanisme" was coined, and the term "aménagement" in the 1920s and 1930s with the famous Cornudet law. This situation forced city managers to reconsider the urban ensemble, whose aesthetic dimension is ever-present, even in the modern movement. The notion of beauty is inevitably associated with urban planning.
